

Perceived contribution of study group members

This two question questionnaire is a follow-up portion of the questionnaire which most of you completed regarding a particular “dilemma” several weeks ago. Unlike that questionnaire, this one should take less than a minute or two to complete and is only one page long.* The purpose of this is to gauge whether there are any consistent patterns between how people completed that previous questionnaire and how their colleagues see them.

Thus, it is important and valuable to fill this out even if you didn't complete the previous questionnaire.

In the top row of the table below please list your study group number (eg, "B2" for "blue stream, team 2"). In the second column of the table list the examination numbers of the members of your study group (see the attached lists for names and exam numbers). In the third column list the number of points you assign to that individual, ensuring that the points total 100. In the first column (marked "me"), put an * to indicate your own exam number on the line with your exam number.
